CELEBRATE HOW DIFFERENCES MAKE FRIENDSHIPS STRONGER IN THIS PRODUCTION BASED ON THE NEW YORK TIMES BESTSELLER

(DALLAS, TX) – Popular *New York Times* bestselling children's author Mo Willems is back at Dallas Children's Theater with two beloved characters charming audiences with a play-within-a-play about friendship, positivity, overcoming anxiety, and, of course, theater.

Based on characters from Willems' award-winning *Elephant & Piggie* picture books, *Mo Willems' Elephant and Piggie's "We Are In a Play!"* stars best friends Elephant Gerald and Piggie in a new adventure as they try to put on a play; however, they have *very* different feelings about it. The ever–upbeat Piggie is thrilled to be on stage, while Elephant is a bit busy hoping nothing goes "terribly, horribly, best–friendship endingly wrong." Audiences will see if his worries come true in this comedic yet heartwarming production, performing at DCT from January 21 through February 25.

The show brings to life the dynamic friendship between Elephant and Piggie, promising a delightful experience for audiences. "It's an exploration of the friendship between friends who are opposites of one another but love being together," says Nancy Schaffer, Director of *Elephant and Piggie's "We Are In A Play!"* and Artistic Director and Education Director at Dallas Children's Theater. "They're best friends regardless of how different they are. Gerald is always nervous about things, while Piggie is always ready to jump in, but they don't let that stop them from being friends." This show shares an important message that will help young audiences learn to celebrate what makes their friends unique. Gerald is anxious, but he "knows" parties, and everyone wants to learn his Elephant Dance. Meanwhile, Piggie is excited because she has no idea what will happen but thinks of the possibilities! They know that whatever they do together, they will have fun because no matter what happens, they'll still have each other.

Starring in this production are returning DCT favorites Brian Hathaway from 2020's *Schoolhouse Rock Live!*, playing Elephant Gerald, a cautious Elephant who worries enough that his best friend doesn't have to, and Leslie Marie Collins, from last season's Mo Willems-based production *Don't Let the Pigeon Drive the Bus! The Musical! is* playing Piggie, an adventurous pig who is always smiling. This show features upbeat music and hilarious antics and will leave everyone laughing and dancing in their seats.

"Even though this is a children's book, it feels good for the whole family. Mo Willems adapts his work for the stage and keeps the audience engaged," says Schaffer. "I think audiences will feel joy for the characters and even be on the edge of their seats waiting to see what happens next."

As a bonus show event, as part of the February 24th, 1:30 PM performance, there will be an Elephant and Piggie's Play and Party fundraising event with proceeds benefiting Dallas Children's Theater's Student Matinee Performance Series. Guests will learn Elephant Gerald's Elephant Dance, meet the actors, get special photo and autograph opportunities, and put on their own Elephant & Piggie play. Party tickets are \$60 per person in addition to the show ticket price.
