

GOOSEBUMPS THE MUSICAL: PHANTOM OF THE AUDITORIUM




TEEN SCENE PLAYERS PRESENT

In her new play, Linda Daugherty, DCT's award-winning playwright-in-residence, explores the blurry lines between real life and life online. Cyber-bullying, explicit content and screen addiction impact the lives of a group of teens, leading to tragic consequences.

This classic story of the struggle for survival and a place that feels like home will have audiences on the edge of their seats.

Yana Wana's story exposes an amazing and unknown ancestral connection to the bluebonnet that gives María a renewed sense of self and family pride. You may have read one version in school; now we invite you to come see the legend through the eyes of Yana Wana in this world premiere. A beautiful, original play that illustrates the power of heritage and the value of one's own story — especially one as ancient as the petroglyphs of Texas.




